AWCCS Outreach Service

The Aboriginal Women & Children's Crisis Service offers an Outreach Service in the wider community for Aboriginal women who are experiencing or have experienced Domestic or Family Violence. One of these services is provided at Leichhardt Women's Community Health Centre, based in Leichhardt.

Their address is:

55 Thornley Street (corner Cary Street Leichhardt NSW)

Up to 2 hours (free) parking is usually available outside and in the streets near the centre.

Leichhardt Women's Community Health Centre provides multidisciplinary, preventative health and treatment services.

Leichhardt Women's Community Health Centre

The Outreach Worker is based at Leichhardt Women's Community Health Centre on Tuesdays, once a fortnight (twice a month) from 10am – 1pm.

The worker will be able to assist and support you in many different ways, such as:

- Help with Legal and Housing issues
- Referral and Advocacy
- Connect you to a wide variety of groups or other culturally appropriate services where possible

Clients are referred to the Outreach Worker through referrals within Leichhardt Women's Community Health Centre, or externally by calling the worker on the mobile number provided on the back of this leaflet.

When you arrive for your appointment, the receptionist will direct you to where the worker's office is.
